

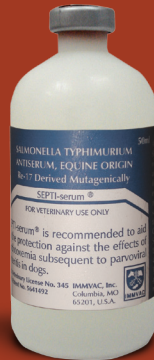

SEPTI-serum should be warmed to body temperature, diluted at least 1:1 with any sterile isotonic solution and administered slowly in not less than 30 minutes. SEPTI-serum is easy to store, handle and use. The 50-mL bottles have a 36-month shelf life if properly refrigerated.
